The primary goal of the CPLC/MCCD Scholarship Program is to provide financial assistance and support to outstanding Arizona Chicano/ Latino students to attend and graduate from one of the Maricopa community colleges. To date, over 240 scholarships have been awarded with a total value of more than \$ 360,000.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ALL APPLICANTS:

1. Incoming freshmen or graduate of a high school or GED Program.
2. Admitted into an associates degree, transfer or certificate program.
3. Enrolled full-time (12 or more credit hours per semester).
4. Cannot be receiving other MCCD recruitment scholarships such as the President's Scholarship or Chancellor's Scholarship

CURRENT RECIPIENT RENEWAL CRITERIA

1. Completed a minimum 12 credit hours per semester.
2. Maintained a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average.
3. Completed a minimum of forty (40) hours of community service

APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND CHECKLIST

1. Application can be neatly hand written or typed. Application form may be copied.
2. Provide a copy of the most recent unofficial grade transcript.
3. Submit a **TYPED** personal statement (maximum of 2 pages double-spaced). Please include the following information in your personal statement.
 - Brief family history
 - Community involvement, leadership and/or volunteer activities
 - Academic achievements and honors scholarships received. (Include dates and amounts awarded)
 - Career plans & educational goals including major course of study.
 - Description of how the scholarship award will be utilized to fulfill your educational goals.
4. Successful recipients of this scholarship must agree to do a minimum of 40 hours of community service.
