***Chicanos Por La Causa and NALCAB to Hold Second Annual National
Neighborhood Stabilization Collaborative Conference in Phoenix***

PHOENIX, AZ – Chicanos Por La Causa, Inc. (CPLC), as the lead agency for a national consortium of high-capacity, non-profit affordable housing developers, will hold its “Second Annual National Neighborhood Stabilization Collaborative Conference” April 27-29 at the Hyatt Regency Hotel in Downtown Phoenix.

The Department of Housing and Urban Development selected CPLC/ NALCAB Consortium under the Neighborhood Stabilization Program for an award totaling \$137,107,133.

This conference brings together all consortium members to evaluate first-year outcomes, and to discuss strategies that have proven successful in overcoming barriers for stabilizing neighborhoods. The success of this program has national and historical implications for CPLC and its collaborators since this award represents one of the largest single federal investments ever made that specifically targets predominately Latino, low-income communities.
